Message Received from Vice Consul Krieg by Mr. Jester.

In connection with transportation of Miss Jones, I am informed by Pan-American that five planes leave every two weeks for Fisherman Lake from Lisbon, and it is probable that space is more easily obtained this way than from the United States directly. She has been advised to go by boat to Lisbon if air transportation from Lisbon can be assured by Department. Please investigate and advise her whether Department can do this.

She should have written evidence of official status to insure transportation from Fisherman Lake to Lagos by Air Transport Command.
